On Shavuot, we remember that the Torah was given not to a select few, but to a nation standing together as one. The mountain was surrounded by an entire people because every person – with their own struggles, strengths, questions, and journey – belongs at Sinai. This day reminds us that there is a place for every soul within the Torah – no one is ever too distant, too imperfect, or too late.

On Shavuot, we stand together again at our own Sinai, each bringing our own story, hopes, and challenges.

Some arrive feeling strong. Some arrive carrying questions. Some arrive feeling broken, distant, or unsure if they belong at all.

But the Torah was given to an entire people – not because everyone was the same, but because every person mattered.

Whether you're full of fiery passion or just barely holding on, this time holds a place for you. Standing at Sinai was never about perfection; it was about presence. You do not need to have everything figured out to stand at the mountain. You only need to be willing.

The Torah was given with open arms, and those arms are still wide open now.

So come as you are. Bring the weight, the questions, the imperfections.

Wherever you may find yourself, there's a space for you on this mountain.
