



Where does the Prohibition Apply?

4. The prohibition of *yichud* applies in any place where other people are not expected to walk in or see the people who are secluded there. This would

include:

- A room behind a closed door
- An open place, such as a field, when no one else is usually around
- An area in the street that is not visible to drivers passing by or to people looking out the windows of their homes, or where other people do not

often pass by. (*Shu"t Ridvaz, Chelek 1, 121; Devar Halacha 9:16*)
