14. Since, as we explained, the rules of *yichud* sometimes apply to a brother and sister, when a *shailah* arises (e.g., if the parents travel abroad for a while and leave their son and daughter home alone) **it should be presented to a competent *posek*.** As we have explained, it is impossible to provide halachic guidelines for each case, so a *Rav* needs to be consulted to issue a ruling specific to the details of each situation. 15. So too, if a brother and sister work together regularly in an office, **a *posek* should be consulted to determine the *halachah*.**
