



One Woman with Two Men

3. One woman may be alone with **two** men (or more) if the following conditions are met:

1) The men must be **kesheirim** (upstanding people), not **perutzim** (see the definition of *perutzim* in the previous emails).

2) It is **daytime**.

3) It is in the **city**, not on the road or in the field.

(Rema EH 22:5)

4. For those who follow the *Bais Yosef* (Sefardim/Edut Hamizrach), there is a prohibition of *yichud* for a woman to be alone with any two (or more)

men. (*Shulchan Aruch* EH 22:5)
