



One Man with Three Women in Someone Else's Office

20. If a man has to go to another person's office or store, etc., where he will be alone with three or more women with whom he is not "*libo gas bah*" and he is also not "*isko im hanashim*," there is no prohibition of *yichud*.

21. However, if it is a situation of "*libo gas bah*" or "*isko im hanashim*," there would be a prohibition of *yichud*. Therefore, when one has to go to somebody else's office or store and the only women who work there are those with whom he regularly does business, there is an *issur yichud* even if there are three or more women.

(As we've explained, the leniency of three or more women will not apply to those who follow the rulings of the *Bais Yosef*. They need to be concerned for *yichud* even when one man is secluded with three or more women.)
