On Sukkos, we step outside the comfort and safety of our homes and enter the humble sukkah – a temporary shelter open to the unpredictable elements. Yet it is precisely there, beneath its simple covering of fragile branches, that we are to discover the deepest sense of peace and protection.

More than a dwelling, the sukkah represents Hashem's warm embrace. It is as if He pulls us close and holds us tight, reminding us that no matter how vulnerable or exposed we may feel, no matter how harsh the environment, we are cradled in His loving arms.
